# The Vine Hotel

### Funchal


The design of the Vine Hotel on Madeira Island is based on its name. The purple staircase and metal mesh at the entrance symbolize summer rain, offering a warm welcome.

In the lobby, the restaurant Terra Lounge represents vineyards; a garden with sofas like big baskets and purple cushions the color of wine.

The floor is covered in small round pebbles, representing the beaches of Madeira, with each different color representing the four seasons. Bathroom facilities are also designed in the shape of a grape while the purple swimming pool symbolizes a tank of wine and the Jacuzzi measuring  $16m \times 1.5m$  is a large path, symbolizing the channels of water around the island.

The colors green, grey, purple, and brown in the rooms and public spaces represent the different hues of a grapevine during the four seasons.


